## MEMBERSHIP - Ellis Wheeler

Post 165 has 187 members and usually 12 to 20 members attend the General meetings which are held the second Tuesday of each month. Dues are \$25 for 2007 and \$30 for 2008. Dues collection for new members joining now begin with 2008 although members who are not current for 2007 and wish to keep continuous membership can still pay for 2007 when they pay for 2008.

Our renewal stands at 133 as of this writing. We are at 71.1 % of our goal. If you have not paid your dues for 2008, please do so today.

**Please note:** If you have paid your dues and received your membership card but still get statements in the mail requesting payment, please disregard them. It takes a few months for dues payments to find their way through the process.

## PUFL (PAID UP FOR LIFE)

Members have the choice of annual or Paid Up For Life (PUFL) membership. The PUFL this year (2007) is attractive because it is offered at the 2007 dues rate of \$25 and next year (2008) will be at the dues rate of \$30.

It is a "good deal", pay once - never have to pay Legion dues again - not even if dues increase several times in the future. Pay one full amount or in twelve equal monthly payments (no difference in the amount to pay). Call the Post home at 259-4117.
