FISHER HOUSE

The Fisher House program supports the military by meeting the needs of America's military beyond those normally provided by the Department of Defense and Veterans Affairs. At times our service men must travel great distances to receive specialized medical care. The Fisher House Foundation builds homes on the grounds of military and VA Medical Centers. These homes provide lodging where families can be with their loved ones during the most stressful times during hospitalization for illness, disease or injury. The policy is the family of the injured veteran being treated can stay at the Fisher House at no cost.

Your American Legion Post #10 has supported the Fisher House and continues to do so. In September 2007 the Post presented a check for \$2000.00 to the Fisher House at Fort Bragg/Pope Air Force Base, NC. This money was raised and donated by Post #10 members. The program depends on public donations to continue the program. It is one of the most efficient charities today with a four star rating by the independent Charity Navigator and a A+ rating by Charity Watch.

This is a program where each legionnaire can participate and directly assist fellow Veteran's. You will be supporting our military and their families and this is what we are all about. Funds are needed to day to build a Fisher House at Camp Lejeune to serve the families of injured Marines. All donations will go 100% towards the construction of the Fisher
