Minutes of the October 9, 2007 Post 67 General Meeting

9. The Cary Christmas parade is Saturday December 8th. We must determine what our participation 'in the parade will be.
10. The October Wake County Veterans meeting has been changed to Wednesday October 24.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30PM.
